

Dear Parents,

Greetings of the day,

Keeping in mind the safety and security, academic achievement of students, and the high level of discipline in the school you are requested to take serious note of the following:

1. Parents/visitors are not allowed to visit school from Monday to Friday between 08:00am and 02:00 pm. Parents who want to visit the school for any purpose are allowed from 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm on Tuesday and Friday or on Saturdays (except second Saturday of the month) between 08:00 am and 9:00am. However, if parents have any urgent issue to discuss or are called by any head for any specific purpose, they may be allowed after taking permission at the school reception counter.
2. For the purchase of uniform and books etc. parents are allowed to go to tuck shop only in the morning between 07:30 and 08:00am and in the afternoon between 02:00 and 3:00 pm. On 1st and 3rd Saturday parents may visit the tuck shop between 8:00am and 01:00 pm.
3. A few parents have made it a habit of sending their child to school without lunchbox in the morning, they come to school in school hours with lunch box, water bottle etc & force security guards to deliver them to their child. We are sorry to inform you that such practice cannot be allowed now onward as parents are not allowed to visit school between 08:00 am and 02:00 pm.
4. The Parent Teacher Meeting (PTM) is scheduled to take place on 11th May, 2019 for all classes. The timing of PTM is from 08:30 to 11:30am. Please attend the meeting so that you get to know about your child's progress and give your feedback to teachers and authorities.
5. Please be informed that summer break will commence from 16th May,2019 to 30th June,2019 and the school will re-open on Monday 1st July,2019.
6. For the smooth functioning of school, parents are requested to deposit the due fee amount by 10th date of every month by all means.
7. It has been observed that some students are not wearing proper House uniform on Wednesdays and Saturdays as prescribed by the school. Pl ensure that your ward always wears proper uniform or else a fine of Rs. 10/- shall be charged from uniform defaulters on Wednesday & Saturday. It is essential to add here that the collection of the fine is not the motive of school. Rather it is to discourage the child from being a defaulter. School wants to inculcate good moral values in the child.
8. Holiday Home Work has been prepared for all classes to enable students to utilize their time productively during summer break. Please visit school website- www.shikshabharati.in to download the holiday home work of your ward after 16th May, 2019.
9. Parents are strongly advised to avail of the school transport in the larger interest of your wards.
